I. INTRODUCTION

The goal of the Fellowship Program in Reproductive Medicine at ARMC is to train a general obstetrician/gynaecologist to function as an independent consultant in Reproductive Medicine. It will provide advanced training in the subspecialty to fellows wishing to pursue a career in clinical reproductive medicine. The program is an in house training program, where the Certificate of Fellowship will be issued upon completion of satisfactory training by the institute with no affiliation to any Universities.

II. OBJECTIVES

It is the program's objective that the fellows achieve the followings:

1. Experience in the management of a wide variety of clinical problems affecting the human reproductive system both male and female.
2. Adequate and diverse surgical experience related to infertility including operative laparoscopy and hysteroscopy procedures
3. ART Procedures including OPU and ET
4. Knowledge of different techniques of various IVF and andrology laboratory procedures
5. Knowledge and experience of Ultrasonography during infertility management specially folliculometry for IUI & IVF by TVS
6. Start controlled ovarian stimulation for IUI & IVF and can tailor stimulation protocols as per patients need.
7. Manage difficult cases of poor ovarian responders, OHSS
8. To be proficient to do reproductive medicine practice independently after the fellowship program

III. PREREQUISITES

1. Candidates must have completed training in Obstetrics and Gynecology and hold a specialty certificate, i.e. MD/MS/DNB (O&G)
2. The candidate should be below 40 years of age.

IV. NUMBER OF FELLOWSHIP POSITIONS

Two candidates are accepted in the program every six months. Accepted fellows will start the fellowship training program from 1st May each year

V. RESOURCES

Operating rooms are equipped for operative laparoscopy and microsurgical procedures. Embryology and Andrology laboratories are equipped to conduct hormone assays, sperm function testing and embryo culture. Equipment and experience are available for a wide variety of diagnostic studies, including ultrasonography, sonosalpingography. Fellowship candidates will get ample opportunity to take part in academic programs organised by ARMC, Local FOGSI society and Infertility organisations.

VI. COURSE DIRECTOR

The fellowship in Reproductive Medicine requires one year of training.

VII. ACADEMIC, TEACHING, AND ADMINISTRATION

The main aim of fellowship is to enable him / her to practice with competence in the field of reproductive medicine.

To achieve the goal, the fellow must deepen their basic knowledge in reproductive medicine beyond what they acquire in their training as general Obstetrician / Gynaecologist.

- Fellow will take active role in ongoing academic teaching activities, journal clubs and case presentations
- Fellow will attend OPD and IPD cases from 10 am to 10 pm

VIII. HOLIDAYS

The candidate is allowed to take 2 days holidays per month and the holidays cannot be cumulated for more than 7 days at a time.

The candidates have to do two days extra duties for every extra holiday above the permitted number of holidays without any stipend. The attendance will be marked as biometric finger print scanning.

IX. FEES AND STIPENED

1. Once confirmation received, an admission fee of Rs. 250,000/- plus GST(Rs. Two hundred and fifty thousand plus GST) need to be deposited within 15 days of confirmation letter. The admission fees is non-refundable at any circumstances.

2. Bank Details will be provided in confirmation letter.
3. The fellow will get a stipend of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees. Ten Thousand only) per month x 12 months.

X. ACCOMODATION:

The fellows has to arrange their own accommodation. ARMC will help in locating suitable accommodation.
